How to get to Tartu:

Tartu Airport at Ülenurme operates only Finnair flights from and to Helsinki. It is located 9 km from the centre of Tartu. Taxi is available for reaching the town.

Tallinn Airport operates a variety of international flights. It is located at the beginning of the Tallinn-Tartu highway 178 km from Tartu. Convenient [bus transportation](#) directly from the airport to Tartu coach station every hour (wifi, water, headphones, toilet, service in Estonian and English available), it takes 2,5 hours to reach Tartu. [Train](#) from Tallinn Ülemiste Station to Tartu Railway Station is also available, it takes 2 hours to reach Tartu.

Riga Airport (Latvia) operates a variety of international flights. It is located 223 km from Tartu in southwest and it takes 3,5 hours to reach Tartu. Use a private car (or a company, e.g. <https://hansareisid.ee/>) to get to Tartu as the buses operate in an unpleasant time and the ride will take you more than 5 hours. Still, it is possible to get to Tartu by [bus](#) or by [train](#).
